POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

Seasonal Assistants (one), Port Graham Hatchery

Closing date: Open until filled

CIAA has one opening for Seasonal Assistants at Port Graham Hatchery. This is a remote site located in an Alaska village, accessible by air or water. The location of hire will be Port Graham for local residents (Port Graham/Nanwalek) or Kenai for all others. CIAA will provide travel from Kenai to Port Graham, as well as accommodations and food (for those living in CIAA-housing) for the length of employment. Housing is available for those employees who do not live in Port Graham.

These positions are expected to start as soon as possible and end September 30, 2017. Length of employment is dependent upon fish returns. If fish are less than predicted, length of employment may be shortened.

Job description:

These are full-time, temporary, non-exempt positions. Under the direction of the Hatchery Manager, the Seasonal Assistant position will assist with pink salmon broodstock collection, egg takes, and incubation as well as maintenance of the hatchery and its equipment.

Qualifications:

Must be able to live in remote locations, work outdoors in inclement weather and in harmony with fellow employees, operate fishery and water quality sampling gear, and have a working knowledge of basic construction techniques. The use of hand tools, outboard motor and small skiff operation, and outdoor skills are required. Familiarity with sampling and data recording techniques is desirable. Requires the ability to lift, carry, push or pull up to 50 lbs. Must be willing to work long hours. Current CPR and first aid certifications are required.

Compensation:

\$13.00 per hour, overtime eligible.
