### Seasonal Assistants (up to six) Trail Lakes Hatchery

**Closing date:** Applications will be accepted until all positions are filled.

CIAA has up to six (6) openings for Seasonal Assistants working under the Trail Lakes Hatchery program. CIAA will provide accommodations and food for the length of employment.

These positions are expected to start and end as follows:

- Session 1: Resurrection Bay net pen duties and fish transfers: Two (2) Seasonal Assistants, March 25–June 30
- Session 2: Bear Lake smolt enumeration/egg take: Two (2) Seasonal Assistants, May 1–October 30
- Session 3: Bear Lake adult monitoring: Up to two (2) Seasonal Assistants, May 15–July 15

#### **Job description:**

These are full-time, temporary, non-exempt positions. Under the direction of the Hatchery Manager or Assistant Hatchery Manager, the Seasonal Assistant position will assist with a variety of tasks that may include enumeration, rearing, outmigration, egg takes, and maintenance of the hatchery facilities and its equipment.

#### **Qualifications:**

Must be able to live in remote locations, work outdoors in inclement weather and in harmony with fellow employees, operate fishery and water quality sampling gear, and have a working knowledge of basic construction techniques. The use of hand tools, outboard motor and small skiff operation, and outdoor skills are required. Familiarity with sampling and data recording techniques is desirable. Requires the ability to lift, carry, push or pull up to 50 lbs. Must be willing to work long hours. Current CPR and or wilderness first aid certifications are required.
